## About the project

The project addresses the needs of both youth and refugees in order to gain skills and competences like leadership, team-work, critical thinking, along with intercultural competences and problem solving, that will help them fully be included in the European society. The course will focus on methods to prevent radicalization and exclusion.

Participants will have the opportunity to improve their knowledge and skills of the topics discussed, to exchange ideas, good practices in the field of youth / refugees / asylum seekers / migrants and to share their experiences so far.

**Project Objectives:** 

**The main objective** of the project is to help youth workers gain competences in order to support and empower refugees/asylum seekers/immigrants and youth to ensure inclusion and fostering tolerance between people, building a society based on peace and understanding.

This mobility of youth workers is based on non-formal education and learning methods that will help participants experiment, analyse and examine different approaches they can use in their daily youth work activities.

#### Location: online, on Zoom

Methodology: The sessions are designed to have **both theoretical and learning-by-doing activities**, with the aid of non-formal education and experiential learning.

Work to prepare in advance: participants are asked to prepare in advance a mini-research about youth radicalisation and refugees / migrants / asylum seekers situation in their home country / country of residence, which will be presented during a workshop in one of the first days of the project.

Certificate: At the end, participants will receive a **YouthPass certificate** that will confirm their participation and the key competences they developed throughout the online mobility.

## **Preparation of Participants**

The preparation will start prior to the mobility dates. The preparation of is based on the following aspects:

• Preparation for the online activities;

Participants will be asked to prepare in advance a mini-research about youth radicalisation and refugees / migrants / asylum seekers situation in their home country / country of residence, which will be presented during a workshop in one of the first days of the project.

• Practical and logistical preparation for the online activities

Participants will be required to prepare to attend a project held online and will receive full support from the trainers and facilitators team. The participants will receive in advance information about the

digital platforms uses, digital tools and other online instruments that will be used. Participants will also receive an online conduct code of behaviours.

• Preparation of the dissemination actions;

Participants will plan their dissemination actions. They will brainstorm on ideas of what they can do after the project for the dissemination in their community and country. They will make a plan for this that will be shared during the mobility in order to allow the other participants to get inspiration one from the others and to increase the quality of their dissemination actions.

• Personal preparation including learning objectives and personal development objectives;

Participants will set learning objectives and personal development objectives for the project. They will explore their strong and week points in order to know on what to focus during the course. Participants will also be supported by the team of trainers and facilitators with support materials sent on email before the start of the course.
